CONGRESS  
(FLORIANÓPOLIS, 4-10 September 2011)**

**WHEN AND WHERE**

The Congress will be held at the *Centro de Cultura e Eventos da Universidade Federal de Santa Catarina*, Cidade Universitária, Campus Trindade, Florianópolis/SC/Brasil, from the 4th to the 10th September 2010.

**HOW TO REGISTER**

The application form will soon be distributed. You may express your interest to the email indicated in the bottom of this letter. The participation cost will be 200 euros for those registering in advance. Reduction of costs will be made available for participants with limited resources or from lower income countries.

Participants will be entitled with:

- free entrance to all sessions
- right to deliver up to two papers
- Information package, including the book of abstracts

**VOLUNTEERS**

Volunteers are welcome and should express their interest to the email indicated in the bottom of this information. Volunteers will be exempt from paying the registration.

**HOW TO PROPOSE SESSIONS, PAPERS OR POSTERS**

The Congress will offer one major conference per day (one hour plenary session), to be delivered by invited speakers.

The Congress has selected four main transversal themes, and participants are invited to submit papers either within one of these or under another specific topic, you may suggest

1. The first Americans and the origins of Humankind
2. Environment, Archaeology and Heritage
3. Archaeology across the Oceans
4. Global migrations

Participants may submit up to two 20 minutes papers, either proposed for specific sessions or as free contributions. These will be grouped in thematic sessions. Abstracts must be submitted by November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010, with up to 30 lines (Type Times New Roman, 12 pt) in English, French or Portuguese (the use of at least two of the previous languages is recommended).

Participants may also submit proposals of Posters. The abstracts must be delivered in the same deadline and with the same characteristics of the papers.

UISPP Scientific Commissions are invited to organise one hour sessions, aiming at reporting their specific activities and advances (the Presidents of the Commissions are invited to propose their own Commission's session);

The Congress will also offer

1. Mini-courses (2 hours, after dinner, lasting for a maximum of 4 days – proposals of courses are welcome)
2. Exhibitions (posters and other, proposals being welcome)
3. Book-fair (including the release of books published after the XV UISPP world congress)
4. Multi-media ongoing platforms with video presentations (each video with a maximum of 15 minutes)
5. Guided tours to archaeological sites
6. Other available services at the congress
  - a. Banks (Brasil, Santander, Caixa Econômica Federal, HSBC)
  - b. Health (Hospital, Nursing, Urgencies)
  - c. Computers, wi-fi, public telephone
  - d. Restaurants, Bars
  - e. Transports (bus, táxi, vans for guests)
  - f. Translation and information offices
